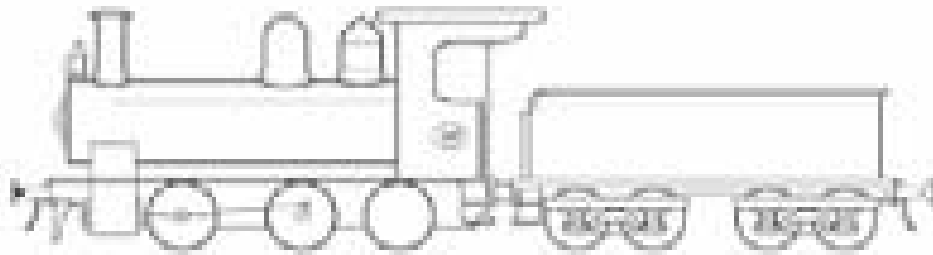


BUILT TO SCALE

Model trains can be made in a variety of sizes. Model trains are built *to scale*, this means that they are the same as real trains but reduced in size. The proportions remain the same.

For example, train B is half the size of train A.

Train A



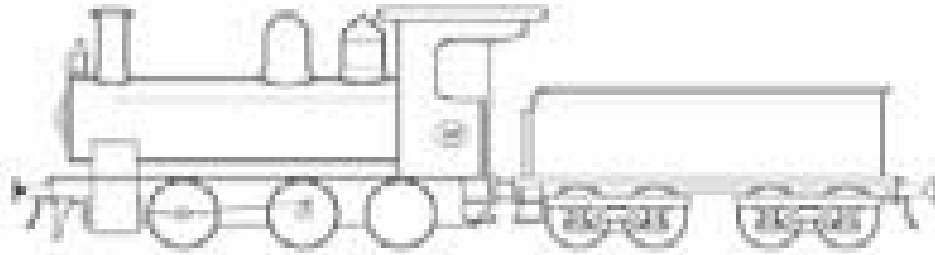
Train B



As a **ratio** this would be written as **1:2** – train B is 2 times smaller than train A.

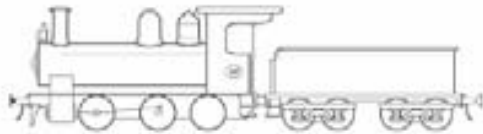
