The Workshops Rail Museum Model Rail exhibit represents different places or themes of rail in Queensland. Can you match the theme with the picture?



Kuranda Railway – The steep climb through the coastal plains through many tunnels and across bridges to Kuranda. The scene captures the majesty and beauty of a tropical rain forest and the ruggedness of the terrain.



Sugar Cane Tramway – Diesel locomotives haul sugar cane bins to and from the mill on a private 610mm gauge railway.



Suburban Trains – A double track electrified suburban rail system using SMU (Suburban Multiple Units).



Coal Line – A busy electrified coal haulage railway in central Queensland with loaded coal trains in one direction and empties in the other. An open cut coal mine and coal loader can be seen together with a coal unloader and coal reclaimer at an export coal port.
